Introduction: motivation, Bell Work (Harry Wong), minds on, hook

Strategies/methods employed and content

Procedure used during lesson and review of concepts

Observations and reflections on professional goals (PGG): intern and co-op teacher

Clear Planning for the Learning Experiences and Instruction

What activities will support the students in meeting the outcomes?

- What instructions will I need to provide?
- What strategies will I use?
- How will I incorporate the Broad Areas of Learning?
- Which Cross-curricular Competencies will this lesson promote?
- How will I infuse Aboriginal perspectives and ways of Knowing and learning?

Plan the assessment & evaluation tools

- They should reflect the objectives and the learning
- Opportunities for additional learning provided – through what other evidence will students demonstrate achievement of the desired results?
- How will my choice support communication with students and parents?
