- If any external requirement course is part of Teaching Area 2, then the requirement will be fulfilled by courses within the Teaching Area.
- <u>Exception</u>: If Social Studies or Indigenous Studies is Teaching Area 2 then one of the external requirements is replaced with an external elective.

Teaching Area Information:

All students in the B.Ed. - Early/Middle Years program have two teaching areas.

- 1. Teaching Area 1 is either **Cree** or **French** and requires a total of 18 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 12 (200-level or higher) credit units.
- Teaching Area 2 options are listed below. Complete program requirements, including a list of courses that meet the teaching area requirements can be found under "College of Education" → Degree Program Routes
 → Language Teacher Education Program at: programs.usask.ca
- Teaching Area 2 (Early/Middle Years) requires a total of 12 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 6 senior (200-level or higher) credit units. (Some teaching areas allow 100-level courses taken after the first 6 credit units to be counted as senior courses. Please consult an academic advisor or the University Catalogue (programs.usask.ca) for details.)
- 4. With **Cree** or **French** as your Teaching Area 1, only 3 credit units of English are required. If English Language Arts is your Teaching Area 2 then English requirements are part of Teaching Area 2 only.
- If Social Science/Social Studies is your Teaching Area 2, at least 6 credit units must contain Canadian content. See the Course and Program Catalogue (programs.usask.ca) for a list of courses that have Canadian content.
- 6. Students may choose **Social Sciences/Social Studies** OR **Indigenous Studies** as a Teaching Area, but cannot choose both.
