All students in the Early/Middle Years B.Ed. program have two teaching areas:

- Teaching Area options are listed below. Complete program requirements, including a list of courses that

  (B.Ed.) → Early/Middle Years Program at: programs.usask.ca
- 2. Teaching Area 1 Early/Middle Years requires a total of 18 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 12 (200-level or higher) credit units.
- 3. Teaching Area 2 Early/Middle Years requires a total of 12 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 6 senior (200-level or higher) credit units.
- 4. If Social Science/Social Studies is one of your teaching areas, at least 6 credit units must contain Canadian content. See the Course and Program Catalogue (programs.usask.ca) for a list of courses that have Canadian content.
- 5. If Modern Languages is one of your teaching areas, only 3 credit units of English are required. If English <u>and</u> Modern Languages are Teaching Areas, then English requirements are part of Teaching Area only.
- Students may choose Social Sciences/Social Studies OR Indigenous Studies as a Teaching Area, but cannot choose both.
