**\*Other External Requirements:**

- If any external requirement course is part of Teaching Area 1 or 2, then the requirement will be fulfilled by courses within the Teaching Area.
- **Exception:** If English, Social Studies and/or Indigenous Studies are Teaching Areas, then **at least one (and at most two)** of the external requirements are replaced with an external elective.

**Teaching Area Options for Early/Middle Years B.Ed.:**

All students in the Early/Middle Years B.Ed. program have two teaching areas:

1. Teaching Area options are listed below. Complete program requirements, including a list of courses that meet the teaching area requirements can be found under “College of Education” → Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) → Early/Middle Years Program at: [programs.usask.ca](http://programs.usask.ca)
2. Teaching Area 1 Early/Middle Years requires a total of 18 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 12 (200-level or higher) credit units.
3. Teaching Area 2 Early/Middle Years requires a total of 12 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 6 senior (200-level or higher) credit units.
4. If Social Science/Social Studies is one of your teaching areas, at least 6 credit units must contain Canadian content. See the Course and Program Catalogue ([programs.usask.ca](http://programs.usask.ca)) for a list of courses that have Canadian content.
5. If Modern Languages is one of your teaching areas, only 3 credit units of English are required. If English **and** Modern Languages are Teaching Areas, then English requirements are part of Teaching Area only.
6. Students may choose Social Sciences/Social Studies OR Indigenous Studies as a Teaching Area, but cannot choose both.
