Teaching Area Options for Elementary/Middle Years B.Ed.:

All students in the Elementary/Middle Years B.Ed. program have two teaching areas:

1. Teaching Area options are listed below. Complete program requirements, including a list of courses that meet the teaching area requirements can be found under “College of Education” → Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) → Elementary/Middle Years Program at: programs.usask.ca
2. Teaching Area 1 Elementary/Middle Years requires a total of 18 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 12 c.u. (200-level or higher) credit units.
3. Teaching Area 2 Elementary/Middle Years requires a total of 12 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 6 senior (200-level or higher) credit units.
4. If Social Science/Social Studies is one of your teaching areas, at least 6 credit units must contain Canadian content. See the Course and Program Catalogue (programs.usask.ca) for a list of courses that have Canadian content.
5. Students may choose Social Sciences/Social Studies OR Indigenous Studies as a Teaching Area, but cannot choose both.
