***Other External Requirements:**

- If any external requirement course is part of Teaching Area 1 or 2, then the requirement will be fulfilled by courses within the Teaching Area.
- **Exception:** If English, Social Studies and/or Indigenous Studies are Teaching Areas, then **at least one (and at most two)** of the external requirements are replaced with an external elective.

Teaching Area Options for Secondary B.Ed.:

All students in the Secondary B.Ed. program have two teaching areas:

1. Teaching Area options are listed below. Complete program requirements, including a list of courses that meet the teaching area requirements can be found under “College of Education” → Bachelor of Education (B.Ed.) → Secondary Program at: **programs.usask.ca**
2. Teaching Areas 1 and 2 must have a minimum average of 60%.
3. Teaching Area 1 requires a total of 24 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 18 senior (200-level or higher) credit units.
4. Teaching Area 2 requires a total of 15 credit units: 6 junior (100-level) credit units and 9 senior (200-level or higher) credit units.
5. If Social Science/Social Studies is one of your teaching areas, at least 6 credit units must contain Canadian content. See the Course and Program Catalogue (programs.usask.ca) for a list of courses that have Canadian content.
6. Students may choose Social Sciences/Social Studies OR Indigenous Studies as a Teaching Area, but cannot choose both.
